दर्ज करवा सकें। साथ ही पहले से दर्ज मतदाता गलतियों होने पर इनमें सुधार के लिए भी आवेदन कर सकें।

जिला चुनाव अधिकारी विनय प्रताप सिंह ने शुक्रवार को अधिकारियों के साथ बैठक में ये फैसला लिया है। बैठक में अधिकारियों के अलावा राजनीतिक पार्टियों व ट्रांसजेंडरों के प्रतिनिधियों ने भी हिस्सा लिया। बैठक में प्रतिनिधियों ने बताया कि शहर में काफी ट्रांसजेंडर मतदाता हैं, जो मतदाता सूची में सुधार करवाना चाहते हैं, जिसके बाद ही जिला चुनाव अधिकारी ने स्पैशल कैम्प लगाने के निर्देश दिए। उन्होंने राजनीतिक पार्टियों के प्रतिनिधियों को चुनाव विभाग की तरफ से मतदाता सूची में नाम दर्ज करवाने के लिए चलाए जा रहे

एडवांस में ही आवेदन भरने के लिए निर्देश

बैठक में उन्होंने अधिकारियों को निर्देश दिए कि 17 वर्ष की आयु पूरी कर चुके सभी नागरिकों के एडवांस में ही एप्लीकेशन भरी जानी चाहिए, ताकि समय आने पर उनका नाम मतदाता सूची में दर्ज कर सकें। इसके अलावा 1 जनवरी, 1 अप्रैल, 1 जुलाई और 1 अक्टूबर को 18 वर्ष की आयु पूरी करने वाले नागरिकों के नाम भी मतदाता सूची में दर्ज करने के उन्होंने निर्देश दिए हैं।

उन्होंने कहा कि योग्य युवाओं का नाम मतदाता सूची में समय पर दर्ज होना चाहिए और इसमें किसी भी तरह की लापरवाही नहीं होनी चाहिए। इस दौरान उन्होंने 9 नवंबर से लेकर 8 दिसम्बर तक रिपोर्ट को भी रिव्यू किया, जिसमें दावे व आपत्तियां, फोटो एंट्री, आधार लिंक, युवा वोटर्स के नाम दर्ज समेत अन्य डाटे को चैक किया।

अभियान के बारे में उन्हें जानकारी दी। कहा कि वह योग्य लोगों को मतदाता सूची में अपना दर्ज करवाने के लिए प्रोत्साहित करें। साथ ही संबंधित बीएलओ के साथ अपनी पार्टी का एक प्रतिनिधि भी नियुक्त करें, ताकि उन्हें उन योग्य लोगों के बारे में जानकारी मिल सकें, जिन्होंने अभी भी मतदाता सूची में अपना नाम दर्ज नहीं करवाया है।

Shri Vinay Pratap Singh assured the representatives that all transgender people who are eligible to enroll in the voter list and will be provided with all electoral services through special camps.
